07	<p>Introduction to the duties of Malaikah (Angels):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Jibraeel (A) : Brought messages of Allah (SWT) to the Prophets</li> <li>➤ Mikaeel (A) : The Angel of rain</li> <li>➤ Israfeel (A) : The blower of the Soor (Trumpet) on the Day of Judgment</li> <li>➤ Izrael (A) : The Angel of death</li> </ul> <p>There are many other Angels with different duties</p>

09	<p>Introduction to Shaitaan – The rejected one:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Shaitaan is also known as Iblees, Satan or Devil</li> <li>➤ Shaitaan (Iblees) disobeyed Allah (SWT)</li> <li>➤ Shaitaan leads you to do bad things</li> <li>➤ Do not follow Shaitaan</li> <li>➤ Say:</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;">أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ</p>

	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>“A’oozu Billahi Minash-Shaitaan ir-Rajeem”</b>          (“ I seek refuge with Allah from Shaitaan-the accursed.”)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Seeking protection of Allah (SWT) from Shaitaan</p>
10	<p>Introduction to the Books of Allah (SWT):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Allah (SWT) sent Books to the Prophets.</li> <li>➤ Names of four Books: Qur’aan, Injeel, Tauraat, and Zaboor</li> <li>➤ Qur’aan was sent to Prophet Muhammad (S)</li> <li>➤ Injeel was sent to Prophet Eesa(A)</li> <li>➤ Tauraat was sent to Prophet Musa (A)</li> <li>➤ Zaboor was sent to Prophet Dawood (A)</li> </ul>
11	<p>Introduction to the Prophets and Messengers of Allah (SWT)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Allah (SWT) chooses Prophets and Messengers</li> <li>➤ They were all men like us but especially chosen by Allah (SWT)</li> <li>➤ They were the most pious people</li> <li>➤ They all brought the message of Allah (SWT) to us</li> <li>➤ Names of four Prophets who brought the Books of Allah (SWT): Dawood (A), Musa (A), Eesa (A), and Muhammad (S)</li> <li>➤ There were many other Prophets ( To be discussed later )</li> </ul>

	<p>b. Names and times of five obligatory (Fard) daily prayers (Salaat):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Fajr (Morning Prayer) <b>الْفَجْرُ</b></li> <li>2. Zuhr (Noon Prayer) <b>الظَهْرُ</b></li> <li>3. Asr (Afternoon Prayer) <b>العَصْرُ</b></li> <li>4. Maghrib (Evening Prayer) <b>الْمَغْرِبُ</b></li> <li>5. Isha (Night Prayer) <b>العِشَاءُ</b></li> </ol> <p>c. Introduction to Wudu (Ablution) No Salaat without Wudu</p>
15	<p>Salaat (Prayers) – 1: <b>Basic Requirements</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Clean body</li> <li>➤ Clean clothes</li> <li>➤ Clean place</li> <li>➤ Wudu</li> <li>➤ Facing towards Kaabah</li> <li>➤ Niyah (intention) of Salaat</li> <li>➤ Performing Salaat individually or in <i>Jamaat</i> (Group) according to <i>Sunnah</i></li> </ul>

17	<p>Introduction to Ramadaan (The Fasting Month):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ One of the Five Pillars of Islam</li> <li>➤ Ramadaan is the Holiest month</li> <li>➤ Fasting is from Sahoor (sunrise) till Iftaar (sunset)</li> <li>➤ During fasting eating and drinking is prohibited</li> <li>➤ Read more Quraan in Ramadaan</li> <li>➤ The good deeds are rewarded more in this month</li> <li>➤ Eid-ul-Fitr marks the end of Ramadaan</li> </ul>
18	<p>Islamic Etiquettes – 1: <b>Cleanliness (Taharah) الطَّهَارَةُ</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Keeping body clean</li> <li>➤ Keeping clothes clean</li> <li>➤ Keeping place clean</li> <li>➤ Washing hands</li> <li>➤ Wudu</li> <li>➤ Show the Video of Wudu (optional)</li> </ul>

19	<p>Muslim Qualities – 1.a: <b>Introduction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Always be clean</li> <li>➤ Always speak the truth</li> <li>➤ Never lie</li> <li>➤ Never harm any body</li> <li>➤ Never steal</li> </ul>

21	<p>Masjid Etiquettes – 1: <b>Introduction</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Entering the Masjid with Right foot in first</li> <li>➤ Introduce important areas of a Masjid like Mimber, Mehraab, Rows, etc.</li> <li>➤ No talking, running, disturbing, etc. in the Masjid</li> <li>➤ Do not walk in front of people praying</li> <li>➤ Exiting Masjid with left foot out first</li> </ul>
22	<p>Muslim Qualities -1.b: <b>Behavior</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Thankful to Allah (SWT) for every thing. (“<i>Al-Hamdu-Lillah</i>”)</li> <li>➤ Respectful to parents and elders</li> <li>➤ Respectful to teachers</li> <li>➤ Respectful to neighbors</li> <li>➤ Respectful of other’s property</li> </ul>
23	<p>Introduction to the First Prophet - Aadam (A):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The first human being created by Allah (SWT)</li> <li>➤ Allah (SWT) created Hawwa as his spouse</li> <li>➤ Hawwa is the mother of all human beings</li> <li>➤ Allah (SWT) taught Aadam (A) the names of everything</li> <li>➤ Shaitaan misled Aadam (A) and Hawwa</li> <li>➤ Story of Prophet Aadam (A) – <i>Jannat</i> (Garden)</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Believers and pairs of all animals and birds boarded the ship</li> <li>➤ The great flood destroyed all the unbelievers of the world</li> <li>➤ Lesson learnt from the story of Nuh (A)</li> </ul>
26	<p>Introduction to Prophet Hud (A) and Salih (A):</p> <p>Prophet Hud (A):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Sent to the people of Aad</li> <li>➤ The people of Aad were: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rich and powerful</li> <li>▪ Built high castles and spacious houses</li> <li>▪ Worshiped stone idols</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ Teachings of Prophet Hud (A)</li> <li>➤ Rejection of his teachings</li> <li>➤ Allah's (SWT) punishment by fierce wind blowing for 8 days and 7 nights</li> <li>➤ Destruction due to (idol worship) <i>Shirk</i> and rebellion</li> </ul> <p>Prophet Salih (A):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Sent to the people of Thamud</li> <li>➤ The people of Thamud were: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Rich and prosperous</li> <li>▪ Built beautiful houses carved in the mountains</li> <li>▪ Sculptures and painting</li> <li>▪ Worshiped stone idols</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ Teachings of Prophet Salih (A)</li> <li>➤ Allah's (SWT) sign → pregnant she-camel out of the mountain</li> <li>➤ Rejection of teachings and killing of the she-camel</li> <li>➤ Allah's(SWT) punishment by a loud shout followed by a violent earthquake</li> <li>➤ Destruction due to <i>Shirk</i> and rebellion</li> </ul>
27	<p>Introduction to Prophet Ibraheem (A)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Born to highest priest of the temple</li> <li>➤ Breaking of the idols</li> <li>➤ Thrown into the fire and</li> <li>➤ Cooling of the fire by the command of Allah (SWT)</li> <li>➤ Chosen as the friend of Allah (<i>Khaleel-ul Allah</i>)</li> </ul>
28	<p>Introduction to Prophet Muhammad (S):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Sent to all Mankind</li> <li>➤ Born in Makkah</li> <li>➤ Last Prophet</li> <li>➤ Qur'an was revealed to him</li> <li>➤ Brought Deen of Islam</li> <li>➤ His companions were called, "<i>Sahabah</i>"</li> </ul>
