14	<p>Discuss Islamic rules of cleanliness</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Washing hands, Keeping clothes and body clean, washroom etiquettes, etc. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Procedure of Wudu 2. Show the Video of Wudu
15	<p>Field Trip to teach Masjid etiquettes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Entering the Masjid with Right foot first 2. Introduce important areas of a Masjid like Mimber, Mehraab, Rows, etc. 3. No talking, running, misbehaving etc. in the Masjid 4. Do not walk in front of people praying 5. Group students for Wudu practice

Shaitaan leads you to do bad things 4. Do not follow Shaitaan 5. Say “Aoozu billahi minash-shaitaan nir-rajeem”, to seek Protection of Allah (SWT) from Shaitaan

During fasting eating and drinking is prohibited 4. Read more Quraan in Ramadaan 5. The good deeds are rewarded more in this month 6. Eid-ul-Fitr is at the end of Ramadaan
