Sunnat-ul-mu’akkadah (Emphasized Prophet’s Sunnah) 2. Sunnat-ul-ghairil-mu’akkadah (Non-Emphasized) ➤ Wajib (Essential) وَاجِبٌ ➤ Nafl (Optional) نَفْلٌ <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 11	<p>Haraam and Halaal: Food and Drink حَلَالٌ وَحَرَامٌ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Halaal – Lawful and permitted by Allah (SWT) حَلَالٌ

	<p>Everything is Halaal except what Allah (SWT) has prohibited</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Haraam – Unlawful and prohibited by Allah (SWT) حَرَام <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alcohol and drugs 2. Blood 3. Carnivorous animals/birds (Dogs, eagle, etc) 4. Dead meat 5. Immolated food (Food offered to any one other than Allah) 6. Swine <p>Note: The saying is “Everything is Halaal except ABCD IS Haraam”.</p>

13	<p>Quraan – 4a: Facts الْقُرْآنُ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Quraan is revealed in Arabic language ➤ The revelation of Quraan was completed in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 22 years, 5 months, and 14 days. ➤ Quraan in English means, “That which is read again and again” ➤ The other names of Quraan are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Al-Furqaan (The Criterion) - Al-Kitaab (The Book) - Al-Zikr (The Remembrance) - Al-Noor (The Light) - Al-Huda (The Guidance) ➤ Quraan has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First Surah - Surah Fatihah - Dua of a Muslim - Read compulsorily in each Rakaat of the Salaat - Last Surah – Surah An- Naas ➤ Quraan is memorized by Millions of Muslims in the world. ➤ Quraan is translated in 103 languages of the world

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Quraan consists of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 7 Manzils (Stages) - 30 Juz (Parts) - 114 Surahs (Chapters) - 540 Rukoo (Paragraphs) - 6666 Aayaat (Verses)
15	<p>Introduction to Hadees الْحَدِيثُ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Traditions of Prophet Muhammad (S); His sayings, deeds, and approvals ➤ Ahadees is plural of Hadees ➤ Practical guide for Muslims in their daily lives ➤ Inspire Muslims to do good deeds and warn them from bad deeds ➤ Help in understanding and practicing the Quraanic teachings ➤ Hadees consists of three parts: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sanad (The chain of authority of narrators) 2. Matan (Main body of the text) 3. Muhaddis (Compiler of Hadees)
